Each year, Crumley Roberts offers 10 scholarships, totaling \$23,000, to students of all ages who are residents of North Carolina, South Carolina and Alabama.

Three types of scholarships are offered by Crumley Roberts. The **Chairman's Scholarship** is available to high school seniors who wish to pursue their education at a four-year university. The **Next-Step Scholarship** is available to community college students who wish to continue their education at a four-year university.
