Crumley Roberts Scholarship Program

Guidelines and Regulations

Crumley Roberts will award three (3) non-renewable \$1,000 scholarships and a laptop computer to high school students who attend school in select counties in the state of North Carolina (**A list of all applicable counties are listed at the end of this document**)

1. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior who will be attending a four-year accredited college or university. Crumley Roberts employees and their family members are not eligible to enter.
2. Applicants will be judged on their community involvement, extracurricular activities and a written essay.
3. Applicants must have a 2.8 GPA or better to apply

Guidelines for submitting the application:

2. Please fill out all fields. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
3. The written essay must be 500 words or less.
4. Applicants must have an official transcript from their High School, letters of recommendation, application and essay sent to the following address **all together in one envelope** to address below:
